

1. Downloading the Application of the Consumer (Applicant) from the SDP if the voltage level required by the Applicant is 132KV or 220KV.
2. Sending the details to the Zonal Chief Engineer of APTransco asking for submitting the field feasibility with alternatives, narrating the sources from where the desired supply can be extended.
Source means:- 132 KV or 220KV Substations
Kadapa, Kurnool, Ananthapuram, Chittoor Districts: - CE/Zone/APTransco/Kadapa
SPSR Nellore, Prakasam, Guntur, Krishna Districts: - CE/Zone/APTransco/Vijayawada.
West Godavari, East Godavari, Visakhapatnam, Srikakulam, Vizianagaram Districts: - CE/Zone/APTransco/ Visakhapatnam.
The Superintending Engineers/APTransco (District level officers) will also be alerted. The field Engineers will visit the exact Location of the upcoming Industry and after physical verification, the proposal will be submitted.
3. Thereby the Zonal Chief Engineer/APTransco will submit the alternatives with his opinions for extension of Supply.
4. The data so received from the Zonal Chief Engineers/ APTransco will be fed to the Chief Engineer/IPC & Power Systems/APTransco.
5. The Grid stability, Network condition at State level is being monitored by the Chief Engineer/IPC & Power Systems. He will examine the proposals, data submitted by the Zonal Chief Engineers and finalize the optimum alternative deciding as how to extend the supply to the Consumer (Applicant).
6. This outcome from the Power Systems wing will be intimated to the Consumer (Applicant) for giving his consent.
7. Subsequent to the receipt of the consent from the Consumer (Applicant) the Chief Engineer/ Construction/APTransco will formulate the Scheme, with Estimated Costs by obtaining the feedbacks from the Zonal Chief Engineer with filed Estimates.
8. The Scheme Cost arrived by the Chief Engineer/ Construction will be intimated to the Consumer (Applicant) giving two options.
 - (a) Option 1:- Execution of Entire Scheme by APTransco by Paying the Scheme Cost (Project Cost) apart from the charges payable to APDISCOMs.
 - (b) Option 2:- Execution of the Project by the Consumer (Applicant) himself by Paying Supervision charges to APTransco, apart from the charges payable to APDISCOMs.
9. After receiving the Payment from the Consumer (Applicant), the Chief Engineer/ Construction / APTransco will be requested to take up the work.
10. Within a reasonable time the project will be completed.
11. The Zonal Chief Engineer will report the Status of the Project after completion.
12. Ensuring the completion of the Project, and after fulfilling the statutory obligations and other formalities, the concerned APDISCOM will be advised to release the service.
13. Ensuring the requisites, concerned APDISCOM will release the service and collect the monthly CC (Current Consumption) charges in usual procedure.
